- Can we review the results and raw data from the online pool survey and community pool forum that led to this RFP? *Link to powerpoint presentation from the community forum at our Carbondale Recreation Home Page Website under Featured Information.*

- Request for access to prior consultants work which produced a preliminary budget and a conceptual design. *Water Technology Inc. produced a conceptual design in 2015.* Here is the link: <https://www.carbondalerec.com/rec-misc/master-plans/>
- Does the “Community Needs Assessment and Aquatics Amenities Survey” need to be a statistically valid survey? *It does not need to be “statistically valid” but it must have enough responses in relationship to the population surveyed to have representative and useful data.*
- Have there been any discussions and resulting decisions on the pool remodel phasing? i.e. is there an intention to maintain some level of access to the pool facility through the construction process? *Optimally, one year of shortened operations on both ends of the normal summer pool season and the construction project completed in between, if possible.*
- Has the Town given consideration to the permanent location of the pool facility? i.e. must it remain in its current location versus being open to relocation, were it to make [economic/operational] sense? *We do not have a Town owned location that would suffice at the present time, so re-location of the pool would mean land acquisition, or losing Town owned parking. If there is an opportunity that the consultants deem feasible a re-location could be possible.*
- Does the Town have the resources to provide written translation of materials that we provide in English to Spanish? *Not to the caliber of a professional translator or native speaker with sufficient translation skills for the translation of written materials for public outreach.*
- Do you have or can you arrange for bilingual staff to be present at any public-facing events? *Not to the caliber of a professional translator for live translation at public events. Some staff have the ability to work one on one with the public to explain or answer questions, but they are non-native Spanish speakers*
